

## WHY BECOME A CONTRIBUTING MEMBER OF WELRIET

#### Current projects.

- 1. Clean- Up of the area, Welriet has Ride on Lawn-mowers, Brush Cutters etc. to ensure we keep our area clean and well maintained. This is also to ensure the safety of our residents.
- 2. Pot Holes, Welriet has joined hands with the two individuals Johan and Jan that have been repairing the potholes
- 3. Safety Welriet supports and maintains the equipment to ensure LS4 CPF can patrol, man the emergency number, monitor the WhatsApp groups.
- 4. Welfare We offer trauma counselling (3 Free Sessions) to residents who have been involved in trauma. We also ensure families dealing with traumatic events are offered meals or basic support.
- 5. Welriet members will be given free entry to Garstkloof Nature reserve once the "Friends of Garstkloof' are up and running.
- 6. Welriet members are able to attend Self Defence classes, as well as other events at a reduced fee or for free.
- 7. Welriet Ladies may with prior arrangement request a patroller to accompany them to their home when arriving home late.
- 8. Welriet members receive a board for their gate as well as a keyring with both emergency and office numbers.
- 9. The more members we have contributing the more projects we can tackle.

## INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT OUR AREA PART 1 GARSTKLOOF NATURE RESERVE



This small nature reserve is approximately 4km if you walk the circumference.

The reserve consists of grasslands with rocky outcrops of dolomite/chert making it an urban gem. With hidden stories and information yet to be uncovered.

The veld abounds in a variety of grasses and flowers, while a variety of indigenous trees like wild gardenia, mispel, stamvrug, rock fig and forest elder grow on the rocky outcrops. Bobbejaanstert, paintbrush lilies and many succulents including the White Lady can be seen. The protected protea caffra and protea welwitschii both flourish along the ridges.

The grasslands are classified as Gauteng Mountain Bushveld and is a protected ecosystem. The views are absolutely beautiful. With this gem right on our doorstep you feel as if you are in the middle of the bush and not the middle of suburbia.

The Apies River starts in the Garstkloof Landfill site and then emerges in Hornblend Park. Gartskloof has one of the highest points in Pretoria.
